# Finalists Announced for the 25th Black Tie Awards

This year, the Chamber received an outstanding **216 nominations** from the community. Nominators were interviewed using a standardized set of questions, and their responses were scored. A round-table panel then reviewed the results to select this year's finalists.

A huge congratulations to all the nominees! The selection process was incredibly challenging, as each nominee demonstrated dedication, excellence, and a positive impact on our community. The Chamber is honoured to continue the Black Tie tradition of recognizing businesses, entrepreneurs, and volunteers who go above and beyond.

Each of the nine award categories, including **Exceptional Customer Experience, Volunteer of the Year, New Business, Arts & Culture, Environmental Excellence, Young Entrepreneur, and Business Excellence for 1-5, 6-19, and 20+ Employees**, has three finalists. All finalists have been notified and have enthusiastically accepted this well-deserved recognition.

With the finalists now decided, the Chamber is excited to move into the next stage of the Black Tie Awards—getting to know the remarkable people behind the nominations.

Over the next month, each finalist will sit down with two adjudicators—one from the category's sponsor and one from the Chamber Board—for a personal conversation about their journey, impact, and achievements. To ensure fairness and transparency, a representative from **Vancouver Island University** will independently review the process.

The winners will be revealed in true Academy Awards style at the **Black Tie Awards Gala** at the **Chemainus Theatre Festival on Friday, April 11, 2025**—a night where the community comes together to celebrate its best and brightest.
